The La Crosse County Jail Chaplain provides pastoral care to women and men incarcerated in the La Crosse County jail. The chaplain organizes all services and studies, provides spiritual material, and works to connect people to their faith communities. The chaplain is the face of the ministry and the first point of contact with the public. The jail chaplain is a professional, with specialized training in the unique dynamics of the corrections world. The chaplain serves in the jail at the invitation of jail administration.

Required

High school diploma or equivalency

Bachelor's degree or successful completion of chaplain or ministry training or equivalent

Desired

Chaplain certification or degree Mental Health First Aid

WORK EXPERIENCE

Required: Three years' ministry or chaplaincy experience or equivalent

Desired: Ministry or chaplaincy experience or equivalent working with corrections involved individuals

Ordained or commissioned to function in ministry by an appropriate religious authority Current faith group endorsement

Compensation

- Additional time for continuing education
